

Eco Ed Day Balta Dam



The Pierce County SCD hosted Eco Ed Day at the Balta Dam last fall. This is a statewide educational program where students (7th graders) learn how every day actions affect the environment. Students are required to visit five different stations throughout the day. The five stations include talks about **Range and Prairie** (Becky Watkins-NRCS), **Soil Health** (Amy Koehler-USDA ARS), **Forestry** (Cody Clemenson-ND Forest Service), **Wetlands** (Cody Jundt-Ducks Unlimited), and **Water Quality** (Emilee Novak (Lachenmeier)-ND Dept. of Environmental Quality). Students take a test before and after the event to see how the day improved their knowledge on the topics covered during the event. The day wraps up with lunch catered by Balta Bar and Grill and free Eco Ed T-shirts.
